## Paleontological Field School

November 4-15, 2024

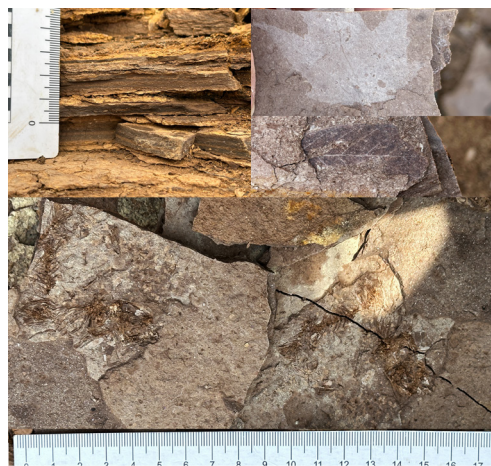
The JURASSICA Museum, in collaboration with partner institutions in Armenia<sup>1</sup> and Kazakhstan<sup>2</sup>, is organizing a paleontological field school at Eo-/Miocene sites in these countries. This research-focused opportunity is specifically designed for advanced Geo- and Paleoscience students to collaborate with researchers and contribute to fieldwork. Students will actively participate in ongoing research at selected outcrops.

We welcome applicants interested in various geo- and paleontological disciplines, including paleobotany, paleozoology, ichnology, micropaleontology, sedimentology, and geochronology. Our objective is to form dynamic teams that will document, sample, and study the geological archives of selected outcrops. This experience will help participants expand their expertise.

The selected outcrops consist of both marine and continental deposits in Armenia and Kazakhstan. To learn more about the field site options, please refer to the application form (see below) where you can also select your preference. The field trip is scheduled for November 4-15, 2024, based on student availability and research group formation. Each group will focus on one outcrop, and study periods will not overlap.

### Organization

We are seeking motivated students, including PhD candidates, from any universities or other academic institutions with an interest in paleontology and/or geosciences. Participants will receive a fixed travel allowance (covering flight and train costs). Accommodation and food will be provided during the fieldwork. The working language will be English.
