International Symposium, April 02 – 06, Dresden, Germany

As already in 2015, in Kunming, China, researchers met for a symposium in Dresden in order to discuss the history of the Yunnan biodiversity hotspot, and to substantiate structure and projects for a NECLIME-associated international large project. The symposium was hosted and organized by Lutz Kunzmann and colleagues with great engagement, and obtained financial support from Dresden Technical University and Senckenberg which is gratefully acknowledged. The symposium included three field days in total, namely visits to open cast mines of the Weisselester and Lower Lusatian Basins, and the Messel fossil site.
