we are pleased to invite you
to the **2nd joint Workshop of the NECLIME Working Groups**
on (3rd meeting) Taxonomy of the Neogene macrobotanical record of Eurasia
and (8th meeting) Taxonomy of Neogene palynomorphs
which will be held at the **Institute of Geological Sciences,**
Masaryk University Brno, Czech Republic,
November 16-17th, 2017

We hope that this meeting will provide an ideal environment to discuss all the relevant topics and meet the friends from abroad in a relaxing atmosphere.

For the presentations and round-table discussion the following preliminary topics are proposed:

1. The application of TLM/SEM on fossil spore/pollen flora as a specific focus.
2. Improvement of the identification and taxonomy of palynomorph taxa with respect to vegetation reconstruction and climatic evaluation. New achievements and advances.
3. Reference palynological, carpological and leaves collections – news and updates, online resources for identification.
4. Taxonomic diversity throughout the Neogene (Cenozoic).
5. The Central European pollen and macroremains record – taxonomy, palaeoecology.
6. Plant Functional Type (PFT) approach in Cenozoic vegetation reconstruction, its advantages and flaws. Good practices.
7. The Palaeoclimate database of NECLIME – recent advances of the working group on digital plant distribution
8. In the frame of the given regional focus we invite contributions on vegetation and climate dynamics, development of environments, and climate variability in time and space – e.g. vegetation reconstruction during the Mid-Miocene Climatic Optimum (MMCO) and Mid-Miocene Climatic Transition (MMCT).

PLEASE feel free to propose to us more topics according to your preference. They will be included and announced in the second circular.

The Venue

The NECLIME workshop will be held at the **Masaryk University in Brno, Faculty of Natural Sciences, Institute of Geological Sciences, Kotlářská 2, Brno, Czech Republic.**

Conference fee
